What is a Wellness Benefit?

We pay you a Wellness Benefit when you or someone in your family undergoes a wellness screening or test. Each covered family member can receive a wellness benefit every 12 months. This cash benefit is paid directly to you to help offset deductible or co-pay costs, or however you choose.

When is this Benefit Available?

You can use this benefit when coverage has been in force for 30 days for Critical Illness or 90 days for Accident.

Wellness Screenings

- Blood test for triglycerides
- Bone marrow aspiration or biopsy
- Breast ultrasound
- CA 15-3 (blood test for breast cancer)
- CA125 (blood test for ovarian cancer)
- CEA (blood test for colon cancer)
- Chest X-ray
- Colonoscopy
- Echocardiogram
- Fasting blood glucose test
- Fasting plasma glucose (FPG)
- Flexible sigmoidoscopy
- Hemoglobin A1C (HbA1c)
- Hemocult stool analysis
- Mammography
- Pap smear
- PSA (blood test for prostate cancer)
- Serum cholesterol test to determine level of HDL and LDL
- Serum protein electrophoresis (blood test for myeloma)
- Skin Cancer biopsy
- Stress test on a bicycle or treadmill
- Thermography
- Thin prep pap test
- Two hour post-load plasma glucose
- Virtual colonoscopy
