

Understanding Your New 2020 Prescription Benefit Program

Your Prescription Benefit Plan through Magellan Rx Management

Effective January 1, 2020, Magellan Rx Management is Niagara Bottling's new prescription benefit provider.

Is Your Drug Covered?

It is very important that you review the new Precision Plus formulary. This formulary can be found within the Important Documents tab at www.niagarabenefits.com. If you do not see the drug you are searching for, it is likely that you will need to move to one of the drugs listed on the Precision Plus formulary. Please contact us at 855.371.9782 so we can assist you with finding a new drug, if necessary.

Prior Authorization

The first time you bring a prescription that needs prior authorization to the pharmacy, your pharmacist should explain that more information from your doctor is needed to determine if your plan covers the drug. Ask your pharmacist to contact your doctor. Your doctor will call the Magellan Rx Prior Authorization department to find out if this drug is covered by your plan.

What if you need a prescription filled immediately?

Magellan Rx's prior authorization phone lines are open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, so a determination can be made right away. If the pharmacist cannot reach your doctor, talk with the pharmacist about filling a small supply of your prescription right away. You may have to pay full price for this small supply.

Preventive Medications: Deductible waived if on the Magellan Rx Expanded Preventive List.

30 Day Supply Medications

Your pharmacy benefit is included in your new Aetna ID Card. Please present your new Aetna ID card along with your medication prescription to any of the 35,000+ retail pharmacies in Magellan Rx's network every time you fill your prescription. You can access a participating pharmacy list at www.magellanrx.com.

90 Day Supply Medications

Your benefit allows you to receive up to a 90-day supply of your medication(s) at a lower price than a standard 30-day supply. Inform your physician of which option you prefer.

Filling a 90-Day Supply at CVS: You may receive up to a 90-day supply of your medication(s) at a participating CVS pharmacy for the same cost as mail order. Have your physician write a prescription for a 90-day supply and present this prescription to your participating CVS pharmacy.

Filling a 90-Day Supply via Mail Service: Ask your physician to write two prescriptions: one for a 30-day supply to get you started (to be filled at your local pharmacy), and one for a 90-day supply, plus additional refills (to be filled at the mail service pharmacy). To get started with mail service, you may:

- *E-prescribe or Fax: Have your doctor e-prescribe or fax your prescription to 1.888.282.1349. Faxed prescriptions may only be sent by a doctor's office and must include patient information and diagnosis for timely processing.*
- *Mail: Mail us your 90-day prescription, completed order form with payment to Magellan Rx Pharmacy, P.O. Box 620968, Orlando, FL 32862.*
